What is the Christian Ministry Certificate?

This is one way Indian Bible College partners with you and Native local churches in the training of its leaders. Through this program you would have an opportunity to study a 16-credit core of Bible and ministry classes: IBC's Christian Ministry Certificate (CMC).

You will be better equipped to serve our Lord Jesus Christ in your own church and be taught by spiritually, academically, and experientially qualified servants of God.

3 Ways to obtain The Christian Ministry Certificate

- 1. ON CAMPUS—IBC offers these six classes every year in Flagstaff during daytime classes. One or two of these are offered in an evening format. New in 2014 will be a summer school format with one-week block classes in May-June!
- 2. ON RESERVATION—For years now IBC has been offering these courses local to where Native believers live. Your AZ or NM church can host an extension class if you have five students for credit or 10 students for audit.
- 3. ONLINE-Brand new in Fall 2013 is the opportunity to take the CMC via the internet! These classes bring the student live into the classroom via webcam.



Classes Offered

- Six Quality Core Courses (16 hours total; individual course credit hours are in parentheses)
- o Bible Survey (3)
- o Bible Study Methods (3)
- o Personal Evangelism & Discipleship (3)
- o Christian Family (3)
- o Introduction to Missions (2)
- o Intro to Christian Education (2)

What Can I Earn?

Upon completion of 16 credit hours a Church Ministry Certificate is awarded to the student. Recipients of this award walk in IBC's May graduation ceremony!

All course notes and PowerPoint will be provided to those that complete any course for credit in order to teach or train others in their local church settings.

How Much Does It Cost?

CREDIT HOURS

\$75.00 per credit hour

AUDIT HOURS

\$40.00 per credit hour

IBC provides a low cost Bible education for students who desire to serve their Lord in a local church setting. All fees are paid to the school at the beginning of the course.
