<sup>3</sup>The Bachelor program is designed to be a four to five year program, however, some students choose to extend their program to six years. Therefore, students who started in the 2018 and 2019 school years have not yet received a Bachelor's degree.

Due to our students needing to work and be involved in ministry while studying, graduation is not time critical at Indian Bible College. We are more concerned with eventual completion. Thus, Indian Bible College uses the following formulas to measure success.

**<sup>1</sup>Overall Completion Rate:** The number of entering students who complete an IBC Program. For example, in the 2015-2016 school year, seven of eleven students completed the CBS program. Five of the eleven students completed the ABS program, and three of the eleven students completed the BBS program.

**<sup>2</sup>Per Program Completion Rate:** The number of entering students who complete a sequential IBC Program. For example, in the 2015-2016 school year, seven of the eleven students completed the CBS program. Five of the seven students completed the ABS program, and three of the five students completed the BBS program.
